GRAND BALLROOM

This elegant and unique ballroom features beautiful hardwood floors, a 27-foot high hand-stenciled ceiling, custom lacy chandeliers, skylights, a fully equipped theatrical stage and a dressing room.

Located adjacent to the Courtyard, the 5500 square foot ballroom can seat up to 320 guests with space for dancing.



LOGGIA ROOM

Overlooking Balboa Park's Plaza de Panama, this charming second floor room accommodates up to 80 guests and room for dancing. Vaulted ceilings with colorfully stenciled beams, Spanish floor tile and French doors, which open onto the two adjoining rooftop terraces, add to the ambiance.



ALHAMBRA ROOM

Located on the second floor, this attractive room comfortably seats up to 60 guests with a dance floor.

Carpeted floor, an open-beam ceiling and French doors that open to a private covered outdoor balcony overlooking the beautiful Casa del Rey Moro Gardens.



FOUNTAIN COURTYARD

As the pre-function space to the Grand Ballroom, this traditional,
Spanish Colonial courtyard offers a lush garden setting. The famous Donal Hord sculpture, "Woman of Tehuantepec," sits as the centerpiece of the Courtyard.




CASA DEL REY MORO GARDEN


These picturesque terraces accommodate up to 300 guests for a wedding ceremony.

HISTORIC ELEGANCE

in the Heart of Balboa Park

The Prado at Balboa Park is a National Historic Landmark. Originally built in 1915, the House of Hospitality building was part of the Panama-California Exposition, a 2-year exhibition in Balboa Park celebrating the opening of the Panama Canal. The building's architecture, artwork and fountains showcase Spanish, Moorish and Mexican design elements including hand-painted, wooden stencil designs on doors, ceilings and beams. The historic space offers more than 22,000 square feet of indoor and outdoor event space including lush gardens, romantic terraces and an elegant Grand Ballroom. Significant restoration work has been done over the years to preserve the historic beauty of this San Diego gem.
